Section 1: Literacy/Reading					
-Write two 5-sentence paragraphs about your favorite subject in school.					
-Choose two movies or video games, write a paragraph about how they are different and how they are the same.					
-Write an Expository piece about three things makes a snow day so special. Be sure to use the Expository pillar.					
-Describe a time you were responsible. "Being responsible means you do the things you are expected to do and you accept the consequences (results) of your actions. Write a 5 sentence paragraph about this time.					
-Interview a parent or grandparent about their life as a child. Write 4 questions and their answers.					
-Read to yourself or your family for 30 minutes. After you're done, write a summary (Somebody, Wanted, But, So, Then) about what you read.					
-Read a story to your family for 15 minutes and then write a paragraph describing the characters, setting, events (plot).					
-Make a 12 word spelling list using a suffix or prefix. Pick 5 of those words and write a sentence using each word.					
-Get on Flocabulary and work for 30 minutes on literacy.					
Section 2: Math					
-Play a board game with your family and write about how you used math to play the board game.					
-Follow a recipe with your family. When you finish, write down the ingredients and how much was used of each ingredient. Now write down how much of each ingredient would be used if the recipe were doubled.					
-Write your multiplication and division facts 1-12 twice.					
-Log in to Prodigy and work for at least 30 minutes.					
-Log in to Zearn and work for at least 30 minutes.					
-Create and solve two word problems.					
-Create equivalent fractions for the following using multiplication or division: 3/4, 5/8, 1/2, 1/3, 7/8, 4/5. Then, create an addition and subtraction problem using two fractions and solve.					
-Calculate how long you spend doing three activities throughout the day and place them on a number line. Ex: Take a shower, eat lunch, play outside, read a book, etc.					
-Create a 7 digit number and write the number in word form, expanded form, and unit form.					
Section 3: Science/Social Studies					
-Write a paragraph to describe how to fold the American Flag or describe how to recite the Pledge of Allegiance.
